GENERAL GUIDELINES

Submit the entries that you feel are of the highest quality. Student and parent/guardian signatures are required on the form. We cannot publish without these. Due to space constraints, we cannot promise to publish an entry from every class or teacher.

WRITING

Submit student writing using Helvetica, Arial, or Times New Roman font. PK-2 entries may be submitted in student handwriting. Entries are mostly published as submitted, with very minor editing. Please edit spelling, punctuation, and grammar. Please make sure student's name is on the writing. **All writing must be submitted via this link: tinyurl.com/595adfwx.** (If entries are received via email or van mail, they cannot be considered.)

ART

Black and white artwork reproduces best, but color may be submitted. Artwork on lined paper or in light pencil cannot be reproduced and will not be considered. **Take a photo or scan your artwork and submit it to: tinyurl.com/595adfwx.** If our graphic artists need your original artwork, they will contact you.

TENTATIVE TIMELINE:

- 23 December 2022..... Entries chosen
- 9 January 2023 Entries to graphic artist
- 3 March 2023..... Rough draft proofed and teachers notified of selections
- 14 April 2023 Final proofing
- 14 April 2023 Additional orders and payment made
- 14 April 2023 Final draft to printer
- 5 May 2023 Printing finished
- 8-19 May 2023..... Harvest sent to schools via van mail
